This is just a year after being awarded \$6.1 million in state funding to move forward with a Bachelor of Science in Nursing program. That's a pretty quick turnaround and shows both the commitment of the State and EWU leadership to quickly respond to the health and worker crisis coming out of Covid 19.



The program is the result of extensive planning and collaboration with healthcare industry partners and is designed to prepare nurses to meet the growing diversity of healthcare needs in our region.

The SIERR Building, located adjacent to the GU/UW Health Partnership Building is also host to EWU's Community Sciences and Disorders Programs. Both programs are part of Eastern's College of Health Science and Public Health. Other degrees include Public Health and Health Care Administration, Physical Therapy, Occupational Therapy, Dental Hygiene and Wellness and Movement Science.
